Your placement in your core classes will be based on your performance in your current coursework, as well as your upcoming state assessments!

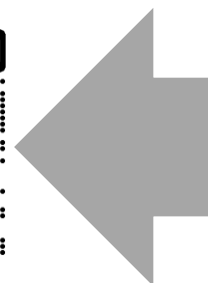
